Proposal for a name of the celestial body # 15760 - 1992 QB1

We suggest the name "Kether"

Reasoning:

This celestial body is still without name since its discovery. This is noteworthy to us, as its existence was the first evidence of the kuiperbelt itself. Consequently it opened up the discovery of a new zone in our solar system.

Especially the astrophysikal anticipation, the kuiperbeltobjects providing knowledge about the materiell composition of the cosmic substance at its very beginning because of their position in the solar system, traces the way back to the idea of the creation of all being.

This goes along with the agreement to name all objects in this zone after worldwide legends of creation, like Quaoar, Sedna or the early vedic Varuna.
